Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by The pro-dean for First-Cycle Studies at the Faculties of Humanities and Theology on 2016-12-14 to be valid from 2016-12-14, autumn semester 2017.

General Information

The course is offered as a freestanding course and can be included in a first or second cycle degree. It is included in the Bachelor of Arts programme in Arabic Studies (HGARA).

Learning outcomes

On completion of the course, the students shall be able to

Knowledge and understanding

- analyse the root and affix system
- master inflections of gender, number and case, uninflected verbs and derived forms, advanced nominal and verbal phrases
- understand and analyse a central vocabulary of approximately 1500 words
- understand coherent oral presentations in simple Arabic

Competence and skills

- form complex sentences in Arabic
- use specialised knowledge of grammar to independently understand and interpret Arabic texts which are more complex than on the previous level
- translate complex sentences from and into Arabic
- communicate in simple everyday situations within a lexical range of approximately 1500 words

Judgement and approach

• identify their need of further knowledge and ongoing learning

Course content

The course expands the study of Arabic grammar introduced in course ARAB15. It includes reading of simple non-fiction texts. Students actively practise reading, understanding and translating Arabic texts. Translation from Swedish into Arabic is trained systematically, as is the use of an Arabic dictionary. All completed grammatical components are practised and learnt in parallel through oral and written exercises within a lexical range of approximately 1500 words.

The course consists of the following modules:

- 1. Elementary Arabic Grammar II, 7.5 credits
- 2. Communicative Arabic II. 7.5 credits

Course design

The teaching consists of lectures and 15-20 exercises. Attendance at exercises is compulsory.

Assessment

The assessment is based on:

Module 1: a written invigilated exam or a take-home exam at the end of the course Module 2: 1-3 compulsory written assignments and an oral and written exam at the end of the course, either in the form of a combined exam or in the form of two partial exams.

The examiner may deviate from the regular form of examination if the student has been granted an alternative form of examination by the Disability Support Services, and if it complies with the learning outcomes of the course.

The examiner may deviate from the regular form of examination if it cannot be implemented during a re-examination, and if it complies with the learning outcomes of the course.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

For a grade of Pass on the whole course, the student must have been awarded this grade on both modules. For a grade of Pass with Distinction on the whole course, the student must have been awarded this grade on both modules.

Entry requirements

To be admitted to the course, students must have passed ARAB15 or the equivalent.
