Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by The pro-dean for First-Cycle Studies at the Faculties of Humanities and Theology on 2011-05-11 and was last revised on 2019-03-11. The revised syllabus applies from 2019-03-11, autumn semester 2019.

General Information

The course is offered as a freestanding course and can be included in a first or second cycle degree.

Learning outcomes

On completion of the course, the students shall be able to

Knowledge and understanding

- account for and compare theories and methods of research in Arabic, especially with regard to linguistics and literary studies
- account for the conditions of the academic writing process

Competence and skills

- adopt a scholarly approach to the compilation and presentation of a delimited written assignment in Swedish or English
- handle and assess source material and secondary literature

Judgement and approach

 adopt a scholarly approach to discuss and assess the role of linguistics and literary studies in the research community

Course content

The course initiates the academic writing process through a written analysis of a delimited material that is discussed in connection with group work. The basics of academic writing are presented and applied.

Course design

The teaching consists of approximately 6 compulsory seminars. Absence is to be compensated for in accordance with the lecturer's instructions.

Assessment

The assessment is based on a written analysis that is to be discussed at a seminar with compulsory attendance.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

Entry requirements

To be admitted to the course, students must have passed ARAA20: Intermediate Course I, or the modules included in that course.
