ENGB02, English: Grammar and Translation, 9 credits

Engelska: Grammatik och översättning, 9 högskolepoäng First Cycle / Grundnivå

Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by the programmes director by delegation from the prodean for first- and second-cycle studies on 2014-03-05 to be valid from 2014-03-05, autumn semester 2014.

General Information

The course is offered as a freestanding course. It can normally be included as part of a first or second cycle degree.

Learning outcomes

On completion of the course the student shall

Knowledge and understanding

- be able to provide a basic account of general grammar, including parts of speech, phrase structure and syntax, as well as descriptive English grammar
- be able to describe the main differences between English and Swedish grammar.

Competence and skills

- be able to carry out a grammatical analysis of English sentences
- be able to write a text in English that is grammatically correct.

Judgement and approach

• be able to assess the appropriateness of different phrases and sentences in English from a grammatical perspective.

Course content

The course deals with grammatical concepts and structures found in the English language with the aim of improving the student's confidence and accuracy. This goal is reflected in the course material which both describes and explains various language structures. With the help of this material, the student carries out both analytical and practical exercises.

The course is divided into two components in so far as grammar and translation are assessed in two separate final exams.

Course design

Teaching consists of online material which the student works with independently, and independent study of the required reading. After each section the student completes a number of assignments which are then submitted.

The course is offered partially as a distance learning course and makes use of interactive information technology. It presupposes that students who enrol on the course understand these conditions and have access to a computer with internet connection. Further information is available from the department regarding technical requirements.

Assessment

The assessment is based on assignments that are to be submitted electronically and on two written exams on campus in Lund at the end of the course. The grades on the two exams are weighed together to determine the final grade on the course (see below).

Subcourses that are part of this course can be found in an appendix at the end of this document.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

For a grade of Pass on the whole course the student must, in addition to having passed the assignments, have been awarded this grade on both exams. For a grade of Pass with Distinction the student must have been awarded this grade on the Grammar exam and at least a Grade of Pass on the Translation exam.

Entry requirements

General requirements and studies equivalent of course English 6 from Swedish Upper Secondary School.

- 1. The course replaces ENGB01.
- 2. The contents of the course are equivalent to the module Grammar and Translation in ENGA01, English Level 1. The credits can only be accredited once towards a degree.
