- account for English morphology, syntax and semantics
- provide a basic account of English language history

- use critical source management to produce an investigative paper in English applying correct referencing and citation techniques
- comply with established time frames and deadlines
- analyse English texts with regard to their linguistic structure


## Course content

The course provides students with further and deeper study of the structure and use of English. Students are also to pursue the practice of planning their time and keeping up with predetermined time frames. In addition, the students will practise information retrieval in libraries and databases as well as writing investigative papers with references.

## Course design

The teaching consists of lectures and seminars.

Assessment The assessment is based on 4-5 written assignments (take-home exam, paper, poster, etc).
