ENGH11, English: Level 1 (1-15) (English language), 15 credits

Engelska: Grundkurs (1-15) (Engelska språket), 15 högskolepoäng First Cycle / Grundnivå

Details of approval

The syllabus is an old version, approved by the programmes director by delegation from the pro-dean for first- and second-cycle studies on 2018-09-17 and was valid from 2018-09-17, spring semester 2019.

General Information

The course is offered as a freestanding course. It can normally be included in a first- or second-cycle degree.

Learning outcomes

On completion of the course, the students shall be able to

Knowledge and understanding

- at a basic level, account for important parameters for learning words and phrases in a foreign language efficiently
- account for the basic features of English phonetics and patterns of intonation
- account for basic structures in general grammar and English grammar
- identify the most important grammatical differences between English and Swedish

Competence and skills

- use phonetic script
- use an extensive general English word and phrase vocabulary, partly receptively, partly productively

Judgement and approach

• assess the appropriateness of different English expressions and sentences from a grammatical perspective.

Course content

The course deals with English language structure with regard to grammar, phonology and vocabulary. The students will practise analysing the English language and account for grammatical and pronunciation phenomena. In addition, the course focuses on the learning of words and idiomatic expressions of different kinds.

The course is divided into the following three modules

- 1. Grammar, 7.5 credits
- 2. Phonetics and Pronunciation, 4.5 credits
- 3. Vocabulary, 3 credits

Course design

The teaching consists of group work, lectures, seminars, workshops and teaching via a teaching platform. Pronunciation practice in a language lab may be included.

Assessment

- 1. The assessment of Grammar (7.5 credits) is based on a written invigilated exam.
- 2. The assessment of Phonetics and Pronunciation (4.5 credits) is based on a written invigilated exam.
- 3. The assessment of Vocabulary (3 credits) is based on one major written invigilated exam at the end of the course, and four minor invigilated exams during the course. The students are expected to take three of the four minor written exams. The results from the minor exams and the result from the major written exam at the end of the course are combined into a final grade for the Vocabulary module.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.

Subcourses that are part of this course can be found in an appendix at the end of this document.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

For a grade of Pass on the whole course, the students must have been awarded this grade on all three modules. For a grade of Pass with Distinction on the whole course,

the student must also have been awarded this grade for 10 credits.

- 1. The course is taught at the Centre for Languages and Literature, Lund University.
- 2. The Grammar module corresponds to the freestanding online course, ENGC02.
- 3. This course is identical to one of the modules included in English: Level 1 (1–30 credits), i.e. English Language (15 credits). This is a part-time (50%) course that is taught throughout the semester and together with the students on the course English: Level 1, 1-30 credits.
- 4. The credits allocated for course content that in whole or in part is commensurate with another course can only be credited once for a degree.
- 5. The module titles in Swedish are:
 - 1. Grammatik
 - 2. Fonetik och uttal
 - 3. Ordkunskap
