## FPRM10, Practical Philosophy: Level 4, 30 credits

### Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by the programmes director by delegation from the prodean for first- and second-cycle studies on 2008-03-07 to be valid from 2008-03-07, autumn semester 2008.

### General Information

The course is offered as a single course. It can normally be included as part of a general degree at the undergraduate or graduate levels.

Teaching language: Swedish or English.

### Learning outcomes

On completion of the course the student shall

### Knowledge and understanding

- be able to demonstrate an in-depth understanding of the current advanced-level philosophical debate concerning the key areas of Practical Philosophy
- be able to partake autonomously in in-depth discussions on advanced issues in the key areas of Practical Philosophy.

### Competence and skills

- be able to contribute constructively to discussions on advanced approaches to problems within the key areas of Practical Philosophy
- be able to examine and assess the validity of philosophical arguments presented in authentic published texts

- be able to formulate his/her own standpoints on advanced philosophical problems
- be able to compose his/her own texts which present correctly and discuss critically advanced philosophical problems.

#### Course content

The course provides the students with an advanced in-depth study of the key areas of practical philosophy. It consists of four optional courses, each worth 7.5 higher education credits. The student can choose to create a course in consultation with the examiner, or choose from a selection of existing courses. The student can also enrol in courses made available by other universities and/or departments which are part of the national network offering second-cycle courses in Philosophy.

### Course design

Teaching consists of lectures and seminars.

### Assessment

Examinations take the form of short essays.

Subcourses that are part of this course can be found in an appendix at the end of this document.

### Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

To be awarded a Pass on the whole course the student shall have the grade of Pass on all sub-courses. To be awarded the grade of Pass with Distinction on the whole course the student shall have the grade of Pass with Distinction on at least 22.5 of the credits on the course and a grade of Pass on the remaining credits.

## Entry requirements

To be eligible for the course requires the successful completion of FPRK01, or the equivalent.
