Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by the programmes director by delegation from the prodean for first- and second-cycle studies on 2014-03-18 to be valid from 2014-03-18, autumn semester 2014.

General Information

The course is a compulsory component of the Master of Arts programme in Language and Linguistics specialising in Japanese.

Language of instruction: Japanese and Swedish Some elements can be taught in English

Main field of studies

Depth of study relative to the degree requirements A1N, Second cycle, has only first-cycle course/s as entry requirements

Learning outcomes

On completion of the course the student shall

Knowledge and understanding

- be able to account for issues in Japanese linguistics
- be able to account for grammatical structures and lexical phrases that occur in selected Japanese texts
- be able to reflect in speech and writing on the Japanese language and Japanese linguistics from the perspective of general linguistics

Competence and skills

- be able to read and translate texts in Japanese on linguistics
- be able to participate in discussions of linguistics based on the required reading

Judgement and approach

• be able to critically assess and judge scholarly assertions on the Japanese language.

Course content

The aim of the course is to provide students with practice in reading and translating texts in Japanese on linguistics. The students are to prepare selected texts for seminars in which aspects of structure and translation are discussed. Further subjects of discussion are the issues of theory and language teaching associated with the texts. In order to place the texts in the context of international research, the students also study international journal articles in English on general and Japanese linguistics.

Course design

Teaching consists of approximately 10 compulsory seminars.

Assessment

The assessment is based on two written assignments and an oral presentation.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

Entry requirements

To be admitted to the course, students must have passed 120 credits in Japanese or the equivalent.
