Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by The pro-dean for First-Cycle Studies at the Faculties of Humanities and Theology on 2015-05-08 to be valid from 2015-05-08, spring semester 2015.

General Information

The course is offered as a freestanding course. It can normally be included in a first or second cycle degree.

Language of instruction: English, Swedish and Chinese

Main field of studies

Chinese

Learning outcomes

On completion of the course, the students shall be able to

Knowledge and understanding

- account for basic methods and concepts that are relevant to the acquisition of Chinese
- identify and account for different didactic methods in the teaching of Chinese
- account for the most common syntactic errors made by Swedish students of Chinese
- account for the most common pronunciation errors made by Swedish students of Chinese

Competence and skills

- provide basic reflections on didactic processes in a teaching situation concerning Chinese
- at a basic level identify and correct the most common syntactic errors made by Swedish students of Chinese
- at a basic level identify and correct the most common pronunciation errors made by Swedish students of Chinese

Judgement and approach

- reflect on cultural differences and similarities manifested in source languages and target languages
- reflect on their development in the field of subject didactics of Standard Chinese and identify their need of further knowledge

Course content

The course consists of lectures and seminars in subject didactics aiming to introduce the students to the profession of instructors in Standard Chinese.

Course design

The teaching consists of lectures, group exercises and seminars including 2-3 compulsory group exercises and 2-3 compulsory seminars.

Assessment

The assessment is based on a written exam and 2-3 written assignments.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

Entry requirements

To be admitted to the course, students must have passed Chinese: Beginners' Course (KINC11) or the equivalent.
