#### General Information

Subject: Greek; Modern Greek

The course is offered as a single course. It can normally be included as part of a general degree at the undergraduate or graduate levels.

# Learning outcomes

On completion of the course the student shall

## Knowledge and understanding

 be able to give an account of the key features in the general and cultural history of Greece with an emphasis on continuity in Greek cultural heritage, from Antiquity to the present day

#### Competence and skills

• be able to communicate his/her knowledge of the subject to an audience with no specialised knowledge in the area

## Judgement and approach

• be able to take a stand on issues relating to gender, ethnicity, cultural encounters and cultural diversity in Greece.

#### Course content

The course concentrates on a number of decisive periods from Antiquity, the Middle Ages and the modern period of Greek history and history of ideas, as well as the development of Greek society and public discussions of ancient Greek society. Greek culture is examined from Antiquity to the present day. An emphasis is placed on examining the influence Greek culture has had on the development of the Western World.

The course consists of the following sub-courses:

- 1. History and the History of Ideas, 7.5 credits,
- 2. Cultural History, 7.5 credits.

## Course design

Teaching consists of lectures and classes.

#### Assessment

Examinations take the following forms: Take-home examination and a written assignment.

Subcourses that are part of this course can be found in an appendix at the end of this document.

## Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

To be awarded a Pass on the whole course the student shall have the grade of Pass on all sub-courses. To be awarded Pass with Distinction on the whole course the student shall have the grade of Pass with Distinction on at least 7.5 of the credits on the course, and a grade of Pass on all remaining credits.
