Details of approval

The syllabus is an old version, approved by Committee for Biomedical, Medical and Public Health Education on 2014-04-02 and was valid from 2014-04-02, autumn semester 2014.

General Information

The course is included in semester 1 of the Master of Science programme in Medicine, and is taught in parallel with the introductory course and *Cell Biology*. It is compulsory.

Language of instruction: Swedish Literature in English may be included.

Knowledge and understanding

On completion of the course, the students shall be able to

- know the fundamental principles of basic nursing care
- describe how the approach and dialogue strategies of the participants and leader can affect cooperation and leadership in a group, and be able to describe the

Competence and skills

On completion of the course, the students shall be able to

- apply the principles of basic nursing care
- find published medical research within a specified field, using online literature searches
- write a review of a scientific article in accordance with instructions

Judgement and approach

On completion of the course, the students shall be able to

- call attention to and take into account the vulnerability of the patient in the care situation.
- act in a respectful and professional way in relation to patients, staff, fellow students and instructors

Course content

Teaching:

Lecture about professional development

Basic nursing care: group work including theory review (comp), clinical training day in elderly care (comp), group discussion (comp).

Group communication and leadership: theory review and skills training in groups (comp), written reflection (comp).

Group seminar on a work of fiction (comp).

Course design

Assessment

Limitation of number of times an exam can be taken:

Students who have failed examinations are entitled to re-take an exam four times. Further opportunities may be granted after a special application. Students who have begun a course under an older programme syllabus are entitled to three re-takes of examinations on the course for one year after the course was discontinued or underwent major changes.

Forms of assessment:

- Written summary, written reflection
- Certificate of attendance at compulsory components
