LATB02, Latin: Beginners' Course II, 15 credits

Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by the pro-dean for first-cycle studies at the Faculties of Humanities and Theology on 2011-06-30 and was last revised on 2016-08-24. The revised syllabus applies from 2016-08-24, autumn semester 2016.

General Information

The course is offered as a freestanding course. It can normally be included in a first or second cycle degree.

Learning outcomes

On completion of the course, the students shall be able to

Knowledge and understanding

- account for basic features of Latin syntax and morphology and parts of Latin vocabulary
- demonstrate so much knowledge of Latin grammar that is needed to translate simple original texts from Latin
- account for parts of classical Roman culture and history

Competence and skills

- apply the major part of Latin grammar for translation of Latin original texts
- use dictionaries for translation from Latin

Judgement and approach

- discern and assess cultural phenomena in Roman society from a historical and European perspective
- judge the importance of the context for the interpretation of a text
- identify their need of further knowledge

Course content

The course provides students with further knowledge of Latin morphology, syntax and vocabulary, and enables them to develop their ability to translate Latin original texts from Antiquity. Furthermore, the course includes study of the parts of the history and cultural history of classical Rome that are of relevance to the texts.

The course consists of the following modules:

- 1. Text and Grammar Study including History and Society I, 7.5 credits
- 2. Text and Grammar Study including History and Society II, 7.5 credits

Course design

The teaching consists of lectures and group exercises.

Assessment

The assessment is based on

Module 1: an oral exam and a written assignment

Module 2: a written exam

The examiner may deviate from the regular form of examination if the student has been granted an alternative form of examination by the Disability Support Services, and if it complies with the learning outcomes of the course.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

For a grade of Pass on the whole course, the student must have been awarded this grade on all modules. For a grade of Pass with Distinction on the whole course, the student must have been awarded this grade on module 2 and at least a grade of Pass on module 1.

Entry requirements

To be admitted to the course, students must have passed LATB01 or the equivalent.
