The aim of the course is to enable students to acquire the following knowledge and skills on completion of the course.

Knowledge and understanding

The student shall on completion of the course

• show good direction towards a developed technical ability on the instrument.

Competence and skills

The student shall on completion of the course

- show good direction towards a developed ability to develop and critically assess own ideas and critically review own and others' viewpoints,
- show good direction towards a developed ability to conceive, plan, carry out and take responsibility for own projects/concerts/events within different contexts,
- show good direction towards a personal musical profile with developed outlines,
- show good direction towards a developed ability to orally or in writing make a
 personal presentation, and a presentation of the music, in front of fellow
 musicians or an audience and also
- show good direction towards a developed ability to think and act flexibly and to adapt to changes and new circumstances.

Judgement and approach

The student shall on completion of the course

- show good direction towards a developed ability to identify personal needs for skill development,
- show good direction towards a developed ability to make assessments considering relevant artistic, social and ethical aspects and also
- show good direction towards a developed understanding of the role of art in society.

Course content

The course can contain presentations, individual work, guest visits, study visits and lectures.

Course design

The course is carried out in the form of projects, individually planned activities and lectures. Attendance is compulsory for projects within the education.

Assessment

Examination of the course is arranged through presentations and continuous assessment. Examination rules, such as examination requirements and mark limits, shall be communicated to the student at the beginning of the course.

Re-examination of the course shall be offered in close connection to the regular examination.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.
