Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by Education Committee of the Performane and Church Music Department on 2017-11-29 to be valid from 2017-11-29, autumn semester 2017.

General Information

Compulsory course in Bachelor's Programme in Music: all specialisations, as well as Bachelor's Programme in Church Music, first cycle 180 credits.

Language of instruction: Swedish and English

Main field of studies

Music

Depth of study relative to the degree requirements

G2E, First cycle, has at least 60 credits in first-cycle course/s as entry requirements, contains degree project for BA/BSc

Learning outcomes

The aim of the course is to enable students to acquire the following knowledge and skills on completion of the course.

Knowledge and understanding

The student shall on completion of the course

- show good direction towards well developed craftsmanship
- in the own music-making/music creating show good direction towards a well developed understanding of the style and expressions of the current repertoire

and also

- show good direction towards experience of methods and processes as well as in-depth studies within the main field of the personal music-making/music creating.

Competence and skills

The student shall on completion of the course

- show good direction towards the ability to describe, analyse and interpret form, technique and content,
- show good direction towards the ability to critically reflect on the personal artistic approach within a wider artistic context,
- show good direction towards the ability to independently create, realize and express personal ideas within the main field of study,
- show good direction towards the ability to identify, formulate and solve artistic problems and problems regarding interpretation,
- show good direction towards the ability to orally and in writing or in a different way describe and discuss own activities and artistic issues, and also
- show good direction towards the ability to carry out artistic assignments within given time frames.

Judgement and approach

The student shall on completion of the course

- show good direction towards the ability to co-operate well with other artists.

Course content

The course prepares for the course Degree Project 2 that also is the final presentation of Degree Project (15 credits). The course consists of a concert part and a reflecting part.

The course contains artistic music performance within the specialisation of the education as well as reflection on working methods, artistic interpretation problems and experiences in the process connected to the independent work (degree project).

Course design

The course includes the student's individual work as well as individual lessons and group lessons, supervision and seminars.

Assessment

The music performing part is assessed through continuous assessment, and at concerts or tests. The reflecting part is assessed through continuous assessment and through written and/or oral presentations/exams.

Examination rules, such as examination requirements and mark limits, shall be communicated to the student at the beginning of the course.

Re-examination of the course shall be offered in close connection to the regular examination.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.

Marking scale: Fail, Pass.

Entry requirements

At least 60 credits courses at first cycle level.
