Learning outcomes

The aim of the course is to enable students to acquire the following knowledge and skills on completion of the course.

Knowledge and understanding

The student shall on completion of the course

- have a broadened understanding of basic harmonic processes and
- have a developed inner hearing.

Competence and skills

The student shall on completion of the course

- have a developed ability to use the piano in different professional contexts and
- have a developed ability to use the piano as support for personal artistic development and creativity.

Judgement and approach

The student shall on completion of the course

• have a developed ability to identify personal needs for skill development.

Course content

The course can contain the following components: melody playing with accompaniment, accompaniment, chord positioning, voice leading, chord colouring, individual creativity, imitation exercises, learning by ear and knowledge of the function of the piano in a backup group. The course is adapted to the student's needs and preconditions (level and main instrument). The course shall serve as support to other studies within the education. The course assumes approved result of earlier course MUUL17.

Course design

The course is carried out in the form of individual lessons and individual work (exercises, preparations).

Assessment

Examination of the course is arranged through continuous assessment. Examination rules, such as e.g. examination requirements and mark limits shall be communicated to the student at the beginning of the course.

Re-examination of the course shall be offered in close connection to the regular examination.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.
