## MUUT11, Composition Incl Composition Seminars 2, 10 credits

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### Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by Education Committee of the Performane and Church Music Department on 2017-11-29 to be valid from 2017-11-29, autumn semester 2017.

### General Information

Compulsory course in Master's Programme in Music: Composition, second cycle 120 credits.

*Language of instruction:* Swedish and English

*Main field of studies*

Music

### Learning outcomes

To independently and on a high level be able to act in musical life, the student shall on completion of the course have acquired the knowledge, skills and values formulated below.

### Knowledge and understanding

The student shall on completion of the course

- have very good knowledge of the musical craftsmanship through awareness of the importance of different parameters,
- have very good knowledge of different composition techniques from a historical perspective and
- have very good knowledge of classical and contemporary repertoire and relevant literature.
- show deepened knowledge and understanding of part or parts of the main field of study, including orientation in current research and development work, and
- have knowledge of artistic processes in general and own working methods in particular.

### **Competence and skills**

The student shall on completion of the course

- show the ability to reflect on the personal artistic approach, and that of others, within a wider artistic context,
- show the ability to independently solve artistic problems and problems regarding interpretation,
- show the ability to create and realize own artistic ideas with a personal expression and
- show the ability to plan the implementation of qualified artistic assignments within given time frames.

### **Judgement and approach**

The student shall on completion of the course

- show the ability to make assessments considering relevant artistic aspects.

### **Course content**

The course contains criticism/assessment/analysis and conversations, held at a high level, concerning the students' own works; overview/analysis of works representing different ensemble and work types within the scope of contemporary stylistic orientations; meetings with professionally active composers; conversations on aesthetics. The course assumes approved result of earlier course MUUT10.

### **Course design**

The course is carried out in the form of individual lessons, seminars, guest lectures, workshops/master classes and individual work (analysis, composition and presentation assignments, exercises, transcriptions and other preparations).

## Assessment

Examination of the course is arranged through continuous assessment and tests/exams. Examination rules, such as examination requirements and mark limits, shall be communicated to the student at the beginning of the course.

Re-examination of the course shall be offered in close connection to the regular examination.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.

## Entry requirements

In addition to general entry requirements for higher education at second cycle level the following specific entry requirements are applied:

Degree of Bachelor in Music 180 credits or the equivalent as well as passed selection based entrance examination for Bachelor's Programme in Music.
