Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by the programmes director by delegation from the pro-dean for first- and second-cycle studies on 2007-11-02 to be valid from 2007-11-02, spring semester 2008.

General Information

The course is offered as a single course. It can normally be included as part of a general degree at the undergraduate or graduate levels.

Language of instruction: Swedish

Main field of studies

Chinese

Depth of study relative to the degree requirements

G1N, First cycle, has only upper-secondary level entry requirements

Learning outcomes

On completion of the course the student shall

Knowledge and understanding

- be able to give a basic account of the political, cultural, social and economic history of China

Competence and skills

- be able to reflect on important relations, situations and transformations in Chinese history

Judgement and approach

- demonstrate a certain ability to assess critically and give perspective to ancient Chinese history
- demonstrate an ability to assess issues affecting contemporary China from an historical perspective.

Course content

The course provides the students with an overview of Chinese history from Antiquity to the so-called reformation of the early 1980s. Thematic in-depth studies take the form of short projects in which the student, in consultation with the lecturer, selects a subject and method of presentation.

The course consists of the following sub-courses:

1. Ancient Chinese History, 7.5 credits,
2. The History of the Republic of China, 7.5 credits.

Course design

Teaching consists of lectures and group exercises.

Assessment

Examination takes the form of written, and where suitable oral, examinations at the end of the sub-courses.

Subcourses that are part of this course can be found in an appendix at the end of this document.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

To be awarded a Pass on the whole course the student shall have at least the grade of Pass on both sub-courses. To be awarded the grade of Pass with Distinction on the whole course the student shall have the grade of Pass with Distinction on at least 7.5 of the credits on the course and a grade of Pass on the remaining credits.

Entry requirements

3. This course constitutes sub-courses 2 and 3 in KINA41.
