Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by the programmes director by delegation from the prodean for first- and second-cycle studies on 2007-11-23 to be valid from 2007-11-23, spring semester 2008.

General Information

The course is offered as a single course. It can normally be included as part of a general degree at the undergraduate or graduate levels.

Learning outcomes

On completion of the course the student shall

Knowledge and understanding

• be able to give a basic account of the political, cultural, social and economic history of Japan.

Competence and skills

• be able to reflect on important relations, situations and transformations in Japanese history.

Judgement and approach

- be able to assess critically and give perspective to assertions relating to early Japanese history
- be able to assess issues concerning contemporary Japan from an historical perspective.

Course content

The course is primarily a chronological overview of Japanese history from the earliest period to the present day. The course provides the students with an understanding of continuity and transformations during various eras of Japanese history, as well as indepth knowledge of the social structures and currents of ideas in Japan. Translated sources are used as a point of departure for discussions.

The course consists of the following sub-courses:

- 1. Early Japanese History, 7.5 credits,
- 2. Modern Japanese History, 7.5 credits.

Course design

Teaching consists of lectures.

Assessment

Examination takes the form of written examinations at the end of each sub-course.

Subcourses that are part of this course can be found in an appendix at the end of this document.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

To be awarded a Pass on the whole course the student shall have the grade of Pass on all sub-courses. To be awarded the grade of Pass with Distinction on the whole course the student shall have the grade of Pass with Distinction on at least 7.5 of the credits on the course and a grade of Pass on the remaining credits.

Entry requirements

General requirements and studies equivalent of course English 6 from Swedish Upper Secondary School.
