General Information

Subject: Ethnology

The course is offered as a single course. It can normally be included as part of a general degree at both the undergraduate and graduate levels. With the approval of the relevant authenticating body, it can also be included in certain professional degrees.

Language of instruction: English

Main field of studies

Ethnology

Depth of study relative to the degree requirements G1N, First cycle, has only upper-secondary level entry requirements

Learning outcomes

On completion of the course the student shall

Knowledge and understanding

• be able to apply ethnological and other humanist concepts and perspectives to his/her studies

Competence and skills

- be able to carry out a scholarly analysis of cultural processes and present his/her own research results and those of others orally and in writing
- be able to describe and problematise European history
- be able to relate critically to scholarly texts

Judgement and approach

• be able to assess various social phenomena from a humanist perspective.

Course content

The course provides an overview of European history from prehistoric times to the present. Particular attention will be paid to how a knowledge and understanding of history is valuable in understanding current political policies and debates.

Course design

Teaching takes the form of group work, lectures and seminars. Group work and seminars are obligatory.

Assessment

Examinations can take the following forms: oral and/or written examinations at the end of the course, and curriculum-based continuous assessment in the form of group or individual assignments, and contributions to seminars.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.
