Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by the programmes director by delegation from the prodean for first- and second-cycle studies on 2014-09-29 to be valid from 2014-09-29, autumn semester 2014.

General Information

The course is an elective component of the Master of Arts programme in Language and Linguistics (HASPV). It can be included in a first or second cycle degree.

The language of instruction is English, Swedish or the language used in the relevant specialisation.

On completion of the course, the students shall be able to

Knowledge and understanding

- provide a specialised account of current research and development within the chosen field
- compile and discuss with insight advanced texts within the chosen field

Competence and skills

- independently identify and formulate relevant issues within the chosen field
- provide a clear written and oral account of the issue on the basis of theories and methods within the chosen field

Judgement and approach

• reexamine and take a critical position on the research situation within the chosen field.

Course content

The course consists of specialised studies within a chosen field of language and linguistics. The specific content is to be determined in consultation with the examiner and adapted to the interests and wishes of the student. The work in the course is to result in a research report that is to be presented in speech and writing at an appropriate seminar.

Course design

The teaching consists of independent study and supervision.

Assessment

The assessment is based on a research report and an oral presentation of this at a seminar.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

Entry requirements

To be admitted to the course, the student must be admitted to the Master of Arts programme in Language and Linguistics (HASPV) and have passed the course Theory of Science for Linguists (LINM12) and compulsory courses totalling at least 15 credits.
