SVEK11, Swedish Language: Level 3 - B. A. Course, 30 credits Svenska: Språklig inriktning - kandidatkurs, 30 högskolepoäng First Cycle / Grundnivå

Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by the programmes director by delegation from the prodean for first- and second-cycle studies on 2007-03-13 to be valid from 2007-03-13, autumn semester 2007.

General Information

The course is offered as a single course. It can normally be included as part of a general degree at the undergraduate or graduate levels. The course is an obligatory part of the bachelor degree in the discipline of Swedish.

Learning outcomes

On completion of the course the student shall

Knowledge and understanding

- be able to demonstrate in-depth knowledge and understanding in various specifically chosen fields within the discipline of Swedish
- be able to account for and apply basic knowledge of scholarly theory and method with an emphasis on those aspects which are central to the discipline of Linguistics

Competence and skills

- be able to discern, formulate, and, from various perspectives, discuss scholarly problems and give suggestions to solutions in an autonomous manner, thereby demonstrating that he/she understands the demands of scholarly study and the nature of solving research problems, and can apply a scholarly approach
- be able to carry out autonomously a simple research study within the discipline of Swedish linguistics, and present his/her findings in the form of a written report, which follows accepted scholarly conventions
- be able to evaluate his/her own scholarly solutions to problems, and those of others, and be able to adopt a scholarly approach to the language
- have a well developed ability to examine critically and evaluate his/her own texts and those of others, and to be able to express him/herself orally and in writing, especially within scholarly genres

Judgement and approach

- be able to identify his/her own need for knowledge and understanding
- be able to discuss and evaluate the place of linguistics in the academic world, and the role of scholarly study for citizens and society as a whole
- be able to discuss issues concerning linguistics and methods of linguistics from an ethical perspective.

Course content

The course includes two elective sub-courses, where the students engage in in-depth studies of their choice within the discipline of Swedish. Linguistic theories and methods are dealt with and further developed in terms of a meta-perspective. Knowledge and skills are then applied to the writing of the degree project in which the student further consolidates his/her proficiency in the use of written and spoken Swedish, in particular within the scholarly genre.

The course consists of three sub-courses:

- 1. Elective Course, 7.5 credits,
- 2. Elective Course, 7.5 credits,
- 3. Degree Project, 15 credits.

The elective courses are chosen from a selection of courses offered by Swedish, linguistics speciality, or other closely related subjects. A list of elective courses is approved by the departmental board, or its designated body, prior to the start of each term. This information is available from the student counsellor.

Course design

Teaching consists of exercises, lectures, and seminars. Obligatory, assessed seminars are included in sub-courses 3, and may also be included in sub-courses 1 and 2.

Assessment

Sub-course 3 is examined by the submission of a degree project which is discussed orally at a seminar. Performance in this seminar attributes to the final grade. In the other sub-courses, examination can take the following forms: oral and/or written tests

at the end of the sub-course, continuous assessment in the form of take-away examinations, papers and seminars.

Passed degree projects at the Faculties of Humanities and Theology can be registered in the LUP Student Papers database if the student so wishes. The student is responsible for uploading the passed degree project as a PDF file in LUP student papers.

To be awarded a Pass on the whole course the student shall have passed all subcourses. To be awarded a grade of Distinction on the whole course the student shall have a grade of Distinction on the degree project.

Entry requirements

To be eligible for the course requires the successful completion of SVEA11 Swedish Language Level 1 and SSLA21 Swedish Language and Literature Level 2, or the equivalent.
