# TEOR43, Theology: Church History - Second Cycle Course II, 15 credits

### Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by the programmes director by delegation from the prodean for first- and second-cycle studies on 2013-10-11 to be valid from 2013-10-11, spring semester 2014.

#### General Information

The course is offered as a freestanding course. It can be included as an elective course in the Master's programme in Religious Studies and Theology. The course can be included in a first or second cycle degree.

## Learning outcomes

On completion of the course the student shall

#### Knowledge and understanding

- be able to independently and in detail account for tendencies and perspectives in the current discussion on church history
- be able to summarise, explain and critically comment on current research and key theories within a few areas in church history

#### Competence and skills

- be able to highly independently analyse, review and deal with material and issues concerning church history
- be able to apply and review advanced historiographical theories in detail
- be able to formulate independent views on advanced issues in church history
- be able to write independent texts correctly describing and critically discussing issues in church history for both national and international audiences
- be able to constructively participate in discussions of advanced issues in theology

#### **Judgement** and approach

- be able to critically and self-critically review his or her own and others' analyses of historical processes and discuss their current relevance
- be able to take responsibility for his or her development of knowledge through self-critical assessments and active acquisition of knowledge

#### Course content

On the basis of prior knowledge, the student selects two areas of church history for detailed study in consultation with the lecturer on the course. The student is to read 1200-1500 pages in each area, selected independently and submitted in a proposed reading list to the lecturer for comments. When the student and lecturer have agreed on titles, the lecturer approves the list.

The following areas are available for selection:

- 1. Early Church History,
- 2. The Middle Ages,
- 3. The Reformation.
- 4. The Modern Period,
- 5. Swedish Church History,
- 6. The History of Eastern Christianity.

# Course design

The course consists of independent study and some supervision.

#### Assessment

The assessment is based on oral and written reports, at least one of which is to address an international academic audience in the form of, for example, a review for a research journal, a conference paper or a research article.

Subcourses that are part of this course can be found in an appendix at the end of this document.

#### Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

In order to be awarded a grade of Pass on the whole course, the student must have been awarded this grade in both the studied areas. In order to be awarded a grade of Pass with Distinction on the whole course, the student must have been awarded this grade in both the studied areas.

## Entry requirements

To be admitted to the course, students must have a Bachelor's degree and have passed the course Church History, Second Cycle Course I, 15 credits (TEOM33).
