# **General Information**

The course is included in the Master's programme in Secondary Education at Lund University.

## Learning outcomes

On completion of the course, the students shall be able to

#### Knowledge and understanding

- account for different theories about second language learning processes and the factors that influence them
- account for general and individual features of the language learning process

#### Competence and skills

- discuss the language learning process from a didactic perspective
- perform simple analyses and assessments of the language development of second language learners

#### Judgement and approach

• informed by a scholarly approach, discuss issues that concern second language learning and multilingualism.

#### Course content

The course provides students with knowledge of the learning of a second language in general and of Swedish as second language in particular. Different theories and strategies for language learning are analysed and discussed, with didactic perspectives as an important component. The module includes specialised discussions of different linguistic, cultural, individual and social factors that influence the learning of a second language. Special emphasis is placed on the importance of the first language for second language learning and thereby the development of multilingualism. Both general patterns and individual differences are studied within the scope of development of a second language.

### Course design

The teaching consists of lectures, seminars, workshops and exercises, both individual and in groups.

#### Assessment

The assessment is based on a written invigilated exam and 1-2 written assignments.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.

#### Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

#### Entry requirements

To be admitted to the course, students must have 24 credits from ÄSAD11 or the equivalent.
