## **ARAC24, Arabic: Communicative Arabic IV, 7.5 credits**

*Arabiska: Kommunikativ arabiska IV, 7,5 högskolepoäng*

First Cycle / Grundnivå

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### **Details of approval**

The syllabus was approved by The pro-dean for First-Cycle Studies at the Faculties of Humanities and Theology on 2011-03-24 to be valid from 2011-03-24, autumn semester 2011.

### **General Information**

The course is offered as a freestanding course and can be included as part of a first or second cycle degree.

*Language of instruction:* Arabic and Swedish

The course is taught in Swedish and Arabic, and occasionally in English.

*Main field of studies*

Arabic Studies - specialization Modern  
Standard Arabic

*Depth of study relative to the degree requirements*

G1F, First cycle, has less than 60 credits in first-cycle course/s as entry requirements

### **Learning outcomes**

On completion of the course the student shall

#### **Knowledge and understanding**

- be able to use all general components of Arabic phonetics, morphology and syntax in both speech and writing

#### **Competence and skills**

- be able to communicate in Arabic in everyday situations demanding a vocabulary of 3000 words
- be able to understand and re-tell simple texts in Arabic on the basis of the current vocabulary

### **Judgement and approach**

- be able to identify the personal need of further knowledge and skills development
- be able to account for perspectives on issues concerning gender, diversity and ethnicity

### **Course content**

The course serves as support to the course ARAC23 Arabic: Elementary Arabic Grammar IV in that all components introduced there are practised and acquired through oral and written exercises. The course provides students with active training in the ability to understand and use Arabic in different contexts, and to read and write texts of different kinds. The course deepens the ability to communicate in Arabic.

### **Course design**

Teaching consists of classes and exercises. Attendance is compulsory at exercises.

### **Assessment**

The assessment is based on an oral and written exam at the end of the course.

### **Grades**

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

### **Entry requirements**

To be admitted to the course students must have passed course ARAA10 Arabic: Elementary Course and ARAC21 Arabic: Elementary Arabic Grammar III.

1. The course is offered at the Centre for Languages and Literature/Arabic.
2. The course replaces ARAB24.
3. The course constitutes a module of ARAA20 Arabic: Intermediate Course I.
4. The course is also offered as part of the BA in Arabic Studies, semester 4.
