Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by the programmes director by delegation from the pro-dean for first- and second-cycle studies on 2008-01-10 to be valid from 2008-01-10, spring semester 2008.

General Information

The course is offered as a single course. It can normally be included as part of a first or second cycle degree. With the approval of the relevant authenticating body, it can also be included in certain professional qualifications.

Learning outcomes

On completion of the course the student shall

Knowledge and understanding

- demonstrate knowledge of a subject area from within the discipline of Exegesis of the Old Testament selected for the composition of an essay

Competence and skills

- be able to identify, process and present a well-defined issue of a scholarly nature from a selected subject area from within the discipline of Exegesis of the Old Testament, linguistics specialisation

- be able to present, discuss and analyse issues, viewpoints and arguments relating to the selected issue in written form, and demonstrate this ability through the composition of a scholarly essay
- demonstrate an ability to present material in writing using a good level of language skills
- be able to discuss critically the essay of another student.

Course content

The course involves the student composing an essay. The student selects the subject of the essay in consultation with his/her tutor. Seminars are held in order to discuss methodological issues, essay drafts and completed essays.

Course design

Teaching consists primarily of tutoring but lectures and obligatory seminars are also included. Seminars are compulsory.

Assessment

Examination takes the following form: The essay is discussed and defended at a seminar. The student is also expected to give formal critique on the essay of another student.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

Entry requirements

To be eligible for the course the applicant must have successfully completed 30 credits in Hebrew Exegesis of the Old Testament, or the equivalent.
