General Information

The course is offered as a freestanding course. It is also included in the Bachelor's programme in English. The course can normally be included in a first or second cycle degree.

Course content

Based on continued study of English grammar, the students practise skills in grammatical analysis and the ability to account for the relationship between form and meaning in language.

Course design

The teaching consists of group exercises, lectures and seminars.

Assessment

The assessment is based on a written invigilated exam.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.
