# ENGE15, English: Academic Writing, 5 credits Engelska: Akademiskt skrivande, 5 högskolepoäng First Cycle / Grundnivå

### Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by The pro-dean for First-Cycle Studies at the Faculties of Humanities and Theology on 2019-02-01 to be valid from 2019-02-01, spring semester 2019.

### **General Information**

This is a freestanding course intended for exchange students only.

Language of instruction: English

#### Learning outcomes

On completion of the course, the students shall be able to

#### Competence and skills

• with access to aids, produce simple, academic texts in English featuring a clear structure, correct paragraphing and correct language.

#### Course content

The course provides the students with practice in reading and understanding English texts, and the ability to express themselves orally and in writing in correct, polished English. Students practise writing short texts of a general nature. The students are also trained in planning their work och adapting to predetermined time frames.

### Course design

The teaching consists of lectures, workshops and teaching via a virtual learning environment.

#### Assessment

The assessment is based on 3-5 minor written assignments and an academic paper. The paper is written in four stages (process writing), all of which must be passed in order for the student to complete the course. All submissions are compulsory and the grade for the course is based both on the process and on the final version.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

### Entry requirements

General requirements and studies equivalent of course English 6 from Swedish Upper Secondary School.
