# **General Information**

This is a freestanding course intended for exchange students only.

#### Learning outcomes

On completion of the course, the students shall be able to

#### Knowledge and understanding

• provide a basic account of important parameters for the efficient learning of words and phrases in a foreign language

#### Competence and skills

• use a considerable lexicon of general English words and phrases, partly receptively, partly productively, in correct speech and writing

#### Course content

Supported by lectures and seminars at the start of the course, students practise efficient word and phrase learning throughout the course. The learning process is mainly in the form of independent study but is supported by some teaching during the course.

#### Course design

The teaching consists of lectures, workshops and teaching via a virtual learning environment.

#### Assessment

The assessment is based on a major written invigilated exam at the end of the course and four minor written invigilated exams during the course. The students are expected to take three of the four minor written exams. The results of the minor exams are added to the result of the major invigilated exam at the end and the total determines the grade for the course.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.
