Learning outcomes

On completion of the course, the students shall be able to

Knowledge and understanding

- account for English morphology, syntax and semantics
- provide a basic account of English language history

Competence and skills

- express themselves in writing in correct English
- search for and use information in English in both libraries and databases
- based on critical source management, produce an investigative paper in English, observing correct reference and citation techniques
- comply with established time frames and deadlines
- analyse English texts with regard to their linguistic structure

Course content

The course provides students with further and deeper study of the structure and use of English. Students are also to pursue the practice of planning their time and keeping up with predetermined time frames. In addition, the students will practise information retrieval in libraries and databases as well as writing investigative papers with references.

Course design

The teaching consists of lectures and seminars.

Assessment

The assessment is based on 4-5 written assignments (take-home exam, paper, poster, etc).

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.
