On completion of the course, the students shall be able to

#### **Knowledge and understanding**

- provide a specialised account of English grammar

#### **Competence and skills**

- analyse English texts with regard to their linguistic structure

### **Course content**

Based on the continued study of English grammar, the students will practise their analytical abilities in grammar and their ability to understand and correctly use English in speech and writing.

## **Course design**

The teaching consists of group exercises, lectures and seminars.

## **Assessment**

The assessment is based on a written invigilated exam.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.

## **Grades**
