# Learning outcomes

On completion of the course, the students shall be able to

### Knowledge and understanding

• provide a specialised account in speech and writing of a specific field of the English language or English literature.

#### Course content

The student is invited to specialise in an elective field of the English language or English literature.

## Course design

The teaching consists of seminars.

#### Assessment

Depending on the nature of the relevant course, different forms of assessment may be applied, such as a written exam, written assignments in the form of a take-home exam, essay, response paper or learning journal, oral presentations and compulsory assessed seminars. The assessment can also be based on the performance of a play.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.
