This is a freestanding course intended for exchange students only.

### Learning outcomes

On completion of the course, the students shall be able to

#### Knowledge and understanding

- provide a specialised account of an elective field of the English language or English literature

#### Competence and skills

- write correct and idiomatic English in an academic register

### Course content

The student is invited to specialise in an elective field of the English language or English literature.

## Course design

The teaching consists of seminars.

## Assessment

Depending on the nature of the relevant course, different forms of assessment may be applied, such as written exam, written assignments in the form of a take-home exam, essay, response paper or learning journal, oral presentations and compulsory assessed seminars. The assessment can also be based on the performance of a play.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.

## Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

## Entry requirements

English: Level 2 or the equivalent.
