Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by the programmes director by delegation from the pro-dean for first- and second-cycle studies on 2015-09-11 to be valid from 2015-09-11, spring semester 2016.

General Information

The course is offered as a freestanding course. It can normally be included in a first or second cycle degree.

Language of instruction: English

Main field of studies

English

Depth of study relative to the degree requirements

G1N, First cycle, has only upper-secondary level entry requirements

Learning outcomes

On completion of the course, the students shall be able to

Knowledge and understanding

- account for the main features of English history and the various peoples that have contributed to the development of the English language
- account for the basic features of English phonetics and patterns of intonation
- account for basic structures in general and English grammar
- identify the most important grammatical differences between English and Swedish

Competence and skills

- express themselves in set situations in spoken English with sufficiently good pronunciation to be easily understood in English-speaking contexts
- use phonetic script

Judgement and approach

- make basic connections between historical events and events and circumstances in our time

Course content

The course provides the students with practice in reading and understanding English texts, and the ability to express themselves orally and in writing in correct, polished English. Moreover, the course deals with the historical background to present-day English society and the development of the English language.

The course consists of the following three modules:

1. History and Culture, 3 credits,
2. Phonetics and Pronunciation, 4 credits,
3. Grammar and Translation, 8 credits,

Please note that module 3 is divided into grammar (6 credits) and translation (2 credits). Grammar and translation have two different examination codes in Ladok.

Course design

The teaching consists of group exercises, lectures, seminars, workshops and teaching via a teaching platform. Pronunciation practice in a language lab may be included.

Assessment

The assessment is based on:

Module 1 History and Culture: Written exam

Module 2 Phonetics and Pronunciation: Written exam

Module 3 Grammar and Translation: Written exams, one in grammar (6 credits) and one in translation (2 credits)

Subcourses that are part of this course can be found in an appendix at the end of this document.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

To be awarded a grade Pass on the whole course, the student must have been awarded this grade on all modules. To be awarded a grade of Pass with Distinction on the whole course, the student must also have been awarded this grade on at least 10 credits.

Entry requirements

General requirements and studies equivalent of course English 6 from Swedish Upper Secondary School.

Further information

1. Module 3, Grammar and Translation is also offered as the freestanding online course ENGB02.
2. The modules on this course are identical to three of the modules included in English: Level 1, 1-30 credits. This is a part-time (50%) course that is taught throughout the semester and together with the students on the course English: Level 1, 1-30 credits.
3. The credits allocated for course content that in whole or in part is commensurate with another course can only be credited once for a degree. For further details see the current registration information and other relevant documentation.
