**ENGH03, English: Level 2 (31-45), 15 credits**  
*Engelska: Fortsättningskurs (31-45), 15 högskolepoäng*  
First Cycle / Grundnivå

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### Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by the programmes director by delegation from the pro-dean for first- and second-cycle studies on 2015-09-11 to be valid from 2015-09-11, spring semester 2016.

### General Information

The course is offered as a freestanding course. It can normally be included in a first or second cycle degree.

### Learning outcomes

On completion of the course, the students shall be able to

#### Knowledge and understanding

- account for English morphology, syntax and semantics
- provide a basic account of the history of the English language

#### Competence and skills

- write correct English without the use of aids
- seek and use information in English in both libraries and databases and, using the sources critically, produce an investigating paper in English with correct referencing and quoting
- analyse English texts with regard to their linguistic structure and compare, assess and argue for alternative analyses

## Judgement and approach

- assess and discuss the appropriateness of different expressions in given contexts

## Course content

Through continued study of English grammar, the students practise their ability to analyse grammar and their ability to understand and correctly use English in speech and writing. In addition, students are trained in information retrieval in libraries and databases and in writing an investigating paper including references. A linguistic survey course provides students with a wider and more specialised orientation in the structure and use of English. The students pursue their training in planning their work and adapting to predetermined time frames

The course consists of the following modules:

1. Grammar and Translation, 5 credits,
2. Written Proficiency, 4 credits,
3. Introduction to Linguistics, 6 credits,

Please note that module 1 is divided into *grammar* (3 credits) and *translation* (2 credits). Grammar and translation have two different examination codes in Ladok.

## Course design

The teaching consists of group exercises, lectures and seminars.

## Assessment

The assessment is based on:

Module 1 Grammar and Translation: Written exams, one in grammar (3 credits) and one in translation (2 credits).

Module 2 Written Proficiency: An independent, academic paper.

Module 3 Introduction to Linguistics: Continuous assessment of written assignments (take-home exam, paper, poster, etc). Short written tests may also be included.

## Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

To be awarded a grade of Pass on the whole course, the student must have been awarded this grade on all modules. To be awarded a grade of Pass with Distinction on the whole course, the student must also have been awarded this grade on at least 10 credits.

## **Entry requirements**

To be admitted to the course, students must have passed ENGA01, English Level 1 or the equivalent (for example ENGH01 and ENGH02).

## **Further information**

1. The credits allocated for course content that in whole or in part is commensurate with another course can only be credited once for a degree. For further details see the current registration information and other relevant documentation.
2. The modules are identical to three of the modules in English: Level 2 (31-60 credits). This is a part-time (50%) course that is taught throughout the semester and together with the students on the course English:: Level 2 (31-60 credits).
