Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by the programmes director by delegation from the pro-dean for first- and second-cycle studies on 2007-03-30 to be valid from 2007-03-30, autumn semester 2007.

General Information

The course is offered as a single course. It can normally be included as part of a general degree at both the undergraduate and graduate levels.

Language of instruction: Swedish

Main field of studies

Ethnology

Depth of study relative to the degree requirements

Learning outcomes

On completion of the course the student shall

Knowledge and understanding

- demonstrate a greater knowledge of cultural analysis as applied in ethnology,
- demonstrate basic knowledge of field work methods and techniques in ethnology,

Competence and skills

- be able to write a project description and implement it in practice,
- demonstrate an ability to absorb theoretical works and apply his/her insights to empirical studies,

- be able to communicate basic research results in a scholarly paper,

Judgement and approach

- be able to evaluate and assess the ethical rules and attitudes that arise in the collection and references to sources.

Course content

The course provides in-depth knowledge and understanding of cultural analysis and methods in ethnology. It also gives practise in field work, the results of which are presented in the form of a paper.

The course consists of three sub-courses:

1. Cultural Analysis II, 7.5 credits,
2. Methods and Techniques, 15 credits,
3. Paper, 7.5 credits.

Course design

Teaching consists of lectures, tutorials and field work. Tutorials and field work are obligatory.

Assessment

Examinations can take the following forms: oral and/or written examinations at the end of the sub-course, or curriculum-based continuous assessment in the form of assignments and paper seminars.

Subcourses that are part of this course can be found in an appendix at the end of this document.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

To be awarded a Pass on the whole course the student shall have passed all sub-courses. To be awarded a grade of Distinction on the whole course the student shall have achieved the grade of Distinction for at least 22.5 higher education credits on the course.

Entry requirements

To be eligible for the course requires the successful completion of ETNA11, or the equivalent.
