General Information

The course is a compulsory component of the Master of Arts programme in Film and Media History (HAFMH). The course can be included in a first or second cycle degree.

On completion of the course, the students shall be able to

Knowledge and understanding

- account for the field of film and media history as a interdisciplinary research area
- account for similarities and differences in the specific research traditions of film studies and media history

Competence and skills

- assess complex phenomena and issues within different contexts of film and media history
- execute and present media history analyses within predetermined time frames

Judgement and approach

- make assessments informed by relevant disciplinary, societal and ethical aspects in the field of film and media history
- account for the potential and limitations of research, its role in society and the responsibility of the individual for how it is used
- identify the personal need for further knowledge and take responsibility for their ongoing learning

Course content

The course provides students with a broader understanding of film and media history as an interdisciplinary field and the historical emergence of the discipline. A further aim of the course is to place film and media history research within the context of research in the humanities.

Course design

The teaching consists of seminars on the required reading and a number of lectures by experts within the various fields. Approximately 2-3 assessed seminars are compulsory.

Assessment

The assessment is based on written assignments and oral presentations, individually and in groups.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.
