# Details of approval

The course is a compulsory component of the Master of Arts (120 credits) programme in Film and Media History (HAFME). It can normally be included in a first or second cycle degree.

# Learning outcomes

On completion of the course, the students shall be able to

## Knowledge and understanding

- account for the field of film and media history, including current research and development in professions associated with the media
- account for a selection of crucial events and lines of development in Nordic and Western media history
- account for and apply key concepts of film and media history

## Competence and skills

- clearly account for and discuss in speech and writing their own projects and conclusions within delimited historical inquiries
- create syntheses of and communicate basic research findings within the fields of film and media history covered by the course
- apply and account for key research methods and theories of relevance to studies in film and media history

# Judgement and approach

- account for the possibilities and limitations of research in the field of film and media history
- apply historical perspectives to the subject matter of the course
- identify the personal need for further knowledge and take responsibility for their ongoing learning

#### Course content

The course provides students with an introduction to the main field of film and media history. It has the character partly of a shared entry point, where students from two different disciplines encounter the area of the field they are less familiar with, and partly of an overview of the main research methods of the field as they are manifested in research primarily from the Nordic countries.

# Course design

The teaching consists of seminars on the required reading and a number of lectures by subject experts. Two to three assessed seminars are compulsory.

#### Assessment

The assessment is based on written assignments and oral presentations, individually and in groups.
