Details of approval

The syllabus is an old version, approved by the pro-dean for first-cycle studies at the Faculties of Humanities and Theology on 2016-02-25 and was valid from 2016-02-25, spring semester 2016.

General Information

The course is offered as a freestanding course. It can normally be included in a first or second cycle degree.

Main field of studies

French

Depth of study relative to the degree requirements

G1N, First cycle, has only upper-secondary level entry requirements

Learning outcomes

On completion of the course, the students shall be able to

Knowledge and understanding

- describe the main features of the development of French
- provide a general description of the global socio-cultural status of French
- describe the main features of French literature
- demonstrate basic knowledge of French society
- use basic terminology for the analysis of literary texts
- use basic terminology for the analysis of the structure of language (grammar),

Competence and skills

- understand spoken standard French on largely familiar topics
- independently read simple texts in French aided by bilingual dictionaries and contrastive grammars

- independently write texts in French at a lexical and grammatical level that does not generally impede understanding
- independently prepare and execute oral presentations in French at a lexical and grammatical level and with a pronunciation that does not generally impede understanding
- discuss French issues in the course content at a lexical and grammatical level and with a pronunciation that does not generally impede understanding
- analyse and compare the structure, themes, style and context of different types of texts and produce different types of texts in French
- apply basic French grammar and vocabulary from a contrastive perspective (Swedish/French),
- identify and use relevant and reliable French-speaking sources of information with assistance

Judgement and approach

- take a critical position on source material and acquired knowledge
- take a position on the ethical aspects of the scholarly approach

Course content

The course is a basic course in French providing spoken and written proficiency training, general knowledge of the French language, French society and French literature. In addition to text study, the teaching includes computer-based exercises, film and other media.

The course consists of the following modules:

1. Oral Proficiency, 7 credits,
2. Written Proficiency, 7 credits,
3. French Language and Grammar, 6 credits,
4. French Literature and Literary Analysis, 7 credits,
5. History of French Language and Literature, 3 credits.

Course design

The teaching consists of lectures and group exercises. It is compulsory for students to attend at least 80% of the lectures and exercises.

Assessment

Module1: Oral Proficiency: Oral exam

Module 2: Written Proficiency: 2-5 compulsory written assignments

Module 3: French Language and Grammar: Written exam

Module 4: French Literature and Literary Analysis: Written exam and 1 compulsory written assignment

Module 5: History of French Language and Literature: Written exam

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

For a grade of Pass on the whole course, the student must have been awarded this grade on all modules. For a grade of Pass with Distinction on the whole course, the student must have been awarded this grade on 20 of the available credits, of which 14 credits must be from modules 1 and 2.
