FRAC01, French: Beginners' Course I, 10 credits

Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by The pro-dean for First-Cycle Studies at the Faculties of Humanities and Theology on 2018-03-16 and was last revised on 2020-02-28. The revised syllabus applies from 2020-02-28, autumn semester 2020.

General Information

The course is offered as a freestanding course. It can normally be included in a first or second cycle degree.

Language of instruction: French and Swedish

Learning outcomes

On completion of the course, the students shall be able to

Knowledge and understanding

- account in Swedish for some elementary aspects of French grammar
- master a rudimentary French vocabulary
- account in Swedish for some of the most basic pronunciation principles of French

Competence and skills

- use some elementary structures in French grammar
- participate in a prepared short, very simple conversation in French
- write simple sentences in French with the help of aids
- understand the basic elements of an oral presentation in well articulated French on familiar topics

• read and understand simple sentences in French with the help of bilingual dictionaries and relevant grammars

Judgement and approach

- discuss and take a position on issues of gender, ethnicity, cultural encounters and cultural diversity from different perspectives
- take a critical position on source material and their own knowledge acquisition

Course content

The course is a beginners' course in French so no previous knowledge of the language is required. The course focuses on spoken and written French, and on French culture.

It consists of two modules: Module I, 5 credits, and Module II, 5 credits.

Module I (5 credits) and Module II (5 credits) provide training in pronunciation, grammar, vocabulary, and basic written and oral communication in French.

Course design

The teaching consists of lessons combining lectures, individual exercises and group exercises in equal measures.

Assessment

Module 1 is assessed through a written invigilated exam

Module II is assessed through a written invigilated exam and an oral presentation

Three opportunities for examination are offered in conjunction with the course: a first exam, a retake and a catch-up exam. Within a year after the end of the course at least two additional examination sessions on the same course content are offered. After this, further re-examination opportunities are offered, but in accordance with the current course syllabus.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

For a grade of Pass, students must have been awarded a grade of Pass for both modules. For a grade of Pass with Distinction, students must also have been awarded the grade of Pass with Distinction for Module II.
