## **FTEB07, Theoretical Philosophy: History of Philosophy, 7.5 credits**

*Teoretisk filosofi: Filosofins historia, 7,5 högskolepoäng*  
**First Cycle / Grundnivå**

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### **Details of approval**

The syllabus was approved by The pro-dean for First-Cycle Studies at the Faculties of Humanities and Theology on 2021-12-21 to be valid from 2021-12-21, autumn semester 2022.

### **General Information**

The course is offered as a freestanding course. It can normally be included in a first or second cycle degree.

### **Learning outcomes**

On completion of the course, the students shall be able to:

#### **Knowledge and understanding**

- give an overview of some important historical directions in the history of theoretical philosophy from Antiquity up to and including the 19th century
- give an overview of several key issues, theories and concepts in the history of theoretical philosophy from Antiquity up to and including the 19th century

#### **Competence and skills**

- in a basic way, relate to and discuss some key directions in the history of theoretical philosophy from Antiquity up to and including the 19th century

## **Judgement and approach**

- account for the value of philosophical and personal critical reflection, regarding various forms of human knowledge and science

## **Course content**

The course provides an introduction to the key issues in theoretical philosophy in a chronological overview of philosophers and philosophical directions from Antiquity up to and including the 19th century.

## **Course design**

The teaching consists of lectures and seminars.

## **Assessment**

The assessment of the course is based on a written exam.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.
