# Learning outcomes

On completion of the course, the students shall be able to:

#### Knowledge and understanding

- give an overview of some important historical directions in the history of theoretical philosophy from Antiquity up to and including the 19th century
- give an overview of several key issues, theories and concepts in the history of theoretical philosophy from Antiquity up to and including the 19th century

#### Competence and skills

• in a basic way, relate to and discuss some key directions in the history of theoretical philosophy from Antiquity up to and including the 19th century

### Judgement and approach

• account for the value of philosophical and personal critical reflection, regarding various forms of human knowledge and science

#### Course content

The course provides an introduction to the key issues in theoretical philosophy in a chronological overview of philosophers and philosophical directions from Antiquity up to and including the 19th century.

## Course design

The teaching consists of lectures and seminars.

#### Assessment

The assessment of the course is based on a written exam.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.
