Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by The Board of the Department of Business Law on 2025-02-12. The syllabus comes into effect 2025-09-01 and is valid from the autumn semester 2025.

Learning outcomes

A passing grade on the course will be awarded to students who:

Knowledge and understanding

- shows an interdisciplinary approach to climate work,
- can analyze oral and written presentations with different scientific starting points.

Competence and skills

- can search, identify and use information sources as well as, by ingesting one independent and critical approach, assess and value the information relevance,
- can present new and previous knowledge orally and in writing,
- can carry out the Climathon based on the conditions given for the current one the event,
- can write an analyzing and argumentative text about a topic that relates to the central parts of the course,

- able to complete tasks independently and in a group within given time frames.

Judgement and approach

- can critically evaluate and develop perspectives on climate work.

Course content

The course aims to provide an interdisciplinary approach to climate work and is carried out within the framework of Climathon. Only students who complete the Climathon can be current for the course.

Course design

Knowledge, skills and abilities according to above are achieved by the student through their own literature studies and through active participation in Climathon and in a PM seminar.

Participation in the Climathon event and the PM seminar is mandatory.

During the course, a final shorter PM work is also carried out which aims to the students must be able to identify and reflect in writing on the current climate work as addressed within the Climathon event.

Assessment

The examination takes place through assessment of participation in the Climathon and writing of a PM.

If so required for a student with a permanent disability to be given one equivalent examination option compared to a student without a disability, so can the examiner after consultation with the university's department of pedagogy student support make a decision on an alternative form of examination for the student concerned.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.

Grades

Grading scale includes the grades: Fail, Pass
Final grades are given for the entire course.

For a passing grade, participation in both the Climathon event and PM writing is required and PM-seminar.

Entry requirements

To be admitted to the course, students must meet the general entry requirements for higher education in Sweden (with the exception of proficiency in Swedish)
