Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by The pro-dean for First-Cycle Studies at the Faculties of Humanities and Theology on 2011-04-13 and was last revised on 2023-03-13. The revised syllabus applies from 2023-03-15, autumn semester 2023.

General Information

The course is offered as a stand-alone course. It can normally be included in a general qualification for both first and second-cycle studies.

Language of instruction: Swedish and Italian

Main field of studies

Italian

Depth of study relative to the degree requirements

G1N, First cycle, has only upper-secondary level entry requirements

Learning outcomes

On completion of the course, the students shall be able to:

Knowledge and understanding

- describe some basic features of the Italian language and its grammar,
- describe at least one selected Italian literary text and its author,
- describe some cultural aspects of the Italian society, e.g. a tradition and some elements of everyday life,
- describe some geographic aspects of Italy such as a tourist destination and one of the larger cities,
- describe some cultural-historical aspects of the Italian society such as some individual of historical importance for the country,

Competence and skills

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This is a translation of the course syllabus approved in Swedish

- communicate in everyday speech and writing in Italian in certain arranged situations,
- use a varied vocabulary in speech and writing,
- apply basic elements of Italian grammar,

Judgement and approach

- identify their need for additional knowledge and skills in the subject
- identify some traditions and cultural phenomena in Italian society and compare them with Swedish circumstances.

Course content

In the course, training in grammar, vocabulary, pronunciation, listening comprehension and oral language proficiency is given. studies of Italian literature and culture are also included to some extent.

The course consists of three modules:

1. Grammar and written language proficiency, 7 credits,
2. Text, 4 credits,
3. Culture and oral language proficiency, 4 credits.

Course design

The course is offered as a distance learning course with the support of a web-based learning platform and/or digital tools. Students are required to participate on this basis and to have access to a computer with an internet connection a web camera. The department will provide information about the technical requirements.

Assessment

Module 1, Grammar and written language proficiency are examined through digitally supervised written examination based on real-time streaming

Module 2, Text, be examined through oral examination based on real-time streaming

Module 3, Culture and oral language proficiency are examined through oral examination using real time streaming.

Camera monitoring takes place in real time. No recording takes place. Live monitoring is required in order to assess the student's knowledge without the student having access to any aids.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

For the grade of Pass on the whole course, the student must have been awarded this grade on all modules. For a grade of Pass with Distinction on the whole course, the

student must have been awarded this grade on at least 11 credits and at least a grade of Pass on the remaining credits, of which 7 from Module 1.
