Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by the programmes director by delegation from the prodean for first- and second-cycle studies on 2014-03-18 to be valid from 2014-03-18, autumn semester 2014.

General Information

The course is a compulsory component of the Master of Arts programme in Language and Linguistics specialising in Japanese.

Learning outcomes

On completion of the course the student shall

Knowledge and understanding

- be able to account for theories, methods and issues of linguistics related to lapanese
- be able to account for aspects of syntax, morphology and semantics of Japanese texts

Competence and skills

- be able to read and translate advanced book chapters and journal articles in Japanese on linguistics
- be able to independently formulate relevant research questions in Japanese linguistics based on the required reading

Judgement and approach

- be able to take a scholarly position on material written in Japanese
- be able to discuss and assess the role of linguistics developed in Japan in the general discipline of linguistics
- be able to take a critical and scholarly position on both traditional Japanese linguistics and general theoretical linguistics.

Course content

The course is a continuation and specialisation of the course Text Course in Linguistics I (JAPM13) and aims to provide students with the ability to translate and discuss advanced texts in Japanese on linguistics. The discussions address aspects of syntax, morphology and semantics as well as the relevance to linguistics of the texts. The texts in Japanese are supplemented with influential and specific articles in English from international journals.

Course design

Teaching consists of approximately 10 compulsory seminars.

Assessment

The assessment is based on two written assignments and an oral presentation.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

Entry requirements

To be admitted to the course, students must have passed the course Text Course in Linguistics I (JAPM13) or the equivalent.
