Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by the programmes director by delegation from the pro-dean for first- and second-cycle studies on 2008-06-17 to be valid from 2008-06-17, autumn semester 2008.

General Information

Subject: Chinese

The course is offered as a free-standing course and can normally be included as part of a first- or second-cycle degree. With the approval of the relevant authenticating body, it can also be included in certain professional degrees.

Language of instruction: Swedish, English and Chinese

Main field of studies

Chinese

Depth of study relative to the degree requirements

G2F, First cycle, has at least 60 credits in first-cycle course/s as entry requirements

Learning outcomes

On completion of the course the student shall

Knowledge and understanding

- be able to demonstrate practically acquired knowledge of the syntax, pronunciation and writing system of standard Chinese
- be able to demonstrate specialised knowledge of the cultural, political and economic circumstances of present-day China
- be able to reflect on work in the country of the target language and the professional routines at a Swedish agency or company abroad

Competence and skills

- be able to use a rich and varied vocabulary on different subjects
- be able to communicate in Chinese about different specialised areas
- be able to use Chinese in authentic situations at the work placement

Judgement and approach

- be able to place Japanese society in perspective and compare it with Swedish society.

Course content

The course consists of a work placement at a Swedish agency or company in China. During the placement, the student will gain practical experience of the use of Chinese at a Swedish workplace in China.

Course design

The course consists of a full-time work placement lasting no less than 20 weeks at a Swedish agency or company in China.

Assessment

On completion of the work placement, students shall submit a report and a certificate from the agency/company stating the nature, scope and length of the placement and how the outcomes have been achieved by the student.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass.

Entry requirements

To be admitted to the course students must have passed the course KINA32, KNDA32 or the equivalent.

Further information

1. Students arrange work placements themselves. The work placement must be approved by the undergraduate studies board before it can be commenced.
2. The credits allocated for course content that in whole or in part is commensurate with another course can only be credited once for a degree. For further details see the current registration information and other relevant documentation.
