Learning outcomes

The course consists of instruction in appropriate artistic techniques.

The aim is to provide students with skills as well as technical and practical knowledge. Major emphasis is placed on the relevance of the technical training to the individual student's artistic work.

Course content

The course in Darkroom gives knowledge in basic black and white photography skills such as darkroom development and printing, plus basic information about the safety prescriptions and regulations in the workshop. After finishing the course, you will be able to develop and print your own analogue materials. Students are expected to take notes, review the videos, and practice the instructions given in class. It is the students' responsibility to further look into subjects that will be touched upon in class.

Each group of the students would be allocated on different dates and individuals would have their own activities in groups so that the possibilities of contact are minimized.

Analog and Digital camera settings; exposure metering; depth of field B&W film processing
B&W paper development
Contact sheets and enlarging
Test strips and print controls
Contrast filters
Dodging and burning
Photographic retouching
Print evaluation
Scanning analog film

Course design

Teaching is mostly in the form of laboratory work with continuous supervision. After an introductory technical review, the students conduct their own projects.

Assessment

For the grade pass the student needs to be at least 80% present at lectures, seminars and workshops and the grade pass on tasks, if any.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.
