Artistic creation course.

The aim is to enhance the students' ability to formulate and show an artistic wholeness.

The aim is the students' comprehensive development for artistic work.

Special importance is attributed to the object that analytical insight should be shown in the artistic creation.

Course content

Prerequisites: "There is no good and evil – there is only POWER." –Voldemort

Power Trip is a two-hour class, build as a flow of movements set to a guided imagery to offer a high-energy workshop. It offers a unique vocabulary of moves and a method of training based on Japanese style body-work.

I am fascinated with uniting various disciplines and developing movement method, that is constantly shape shifting and mind-bending. I call it Power Trip—as it is an intense and invigorating physical and mental experience. You plunge into the depth of your body and imagination coming out with tones of brilliant and very individual insights.

The workshop will provide a taste of different traditions of physical training, through the principles of bio-energetics and core energetics. It is based on Butoh (Japanese Physical theater), as well as incorporates elements of boxing, Ballet, Egyptian Belly dance, Action Theater, Burlesque, Clowning and improvisation.

Course design

The educational form will be workshops.

Assessment

For the grade pass there need to be commitment, presence and participation in in all the phases of the course and a presence of at least 80%.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.
