Details of approval

The syllabus is an old version, approved by Department Board of Malmö Art Academy on 2022-09-09 and was valid from 2022-09-09, autumn semester 2022.

General Information

Elective course within the BFA programme in Fine Arts (KGFKO), as well as the MFA programme (KAFKO) in Fine Arts at Malmö Art Academy, Lund University.

Learning outcomes

The course aims to provide education in adequate artistic techniques. The goal is to give the students skills as well as technically and practically oriented knowledge. Special emphasis is placed on the technical teaching.

Course content

The course provides basic knowledge in plastic lamination, plastic casting and information about the safety regulations in the workshop. After completing the course, you will receive a "driver's license" which entitles you to work in the workshop on your own.

Course design

Teaching takes place primarily in laboratory form with ongoing supervision. After an initial technical review, the students may carry out their own projects. The course can end with a presentation of these projects.

Assessment

For a passing grade, at least 80% attendance is required, as well as, when applicable, an approved project.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass.
