### Learning outcomes

The aim is to enhance the students' ability to formulate and show an artistic wholeness.

The aim is the students' comprehensive development for artistic work.

Special importance is attributed to the object that analytical insight should be shown in the artistic creation.

### Course content

The Lab is a space where students are encouraged to present work in an intimate and safe setting so that they might receive feedback from their peers. Presentations can be of studio practice or of the work of another artist that may be important to highlight or explore. They can be sketches for a project in development or a finished piece that needs feedback. The work and its presentation can utilize canonised forms of presentation (the power point, the artist talk, the film screening) or it can be

much more experimental (performative, improvisatory or involve working with others in order to develop your ideas).

What is important is to use the space for yourself, to develop your work, to create co-interests with your fellow students and to forge connections with others through your own creativity. It is a space for students to try things out, to dare to fail and to help each other grow.

## **Course design**

Each person gets 90 minutes to divide up however they wish: that can mean that you present for 10 minutes and get 80 minutes of discussion, you present for 80 minutes and get 10 minutes discussion (or any other division of time that suits your needs).

Each Lab will contain 4 presentations –so that we can concentrate equally on each participant.

## **Assessment**

For the grade pass the student needs to be at least 80% present at lectures and seminars and receive the grade pass on tasks, if any.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.
