LÄKN14, Elective Course, 7.5 credits Breddnings- och fördjupningskurs, 7,5 högskolepoäng Second Cycle / Avancerad nivå

Details of approval

The syllabus is an old version, approved by The Medical Degree Programme Board on 2021-04-07 and was last revised on 2022-02-09. . The revised syllabus applied from 2022-02-09. , spring semester 2022.

General Information

The course is compulsory and included in semester 11 of the medical degree programme. It provides a broadening or specialisation of themes linked or of relevance to the medical degree programme or the medical profession. The clinical or theoretical broadening and specialisation of the subject may vary depending on the current range and the students' own choices.

Language of instruction: Swedish and English Primarily Swedish, secondarily English in cases where Swedish cannot be used due to geographical location or similar circumstances.

Learning outcomes

The general aim of the course is to provide students with specialisation and broadening in theoretical and/or clinical fields they take a special interest in. Accordingly, students shall broaden and/or specialise their clinical expertise and/or receive training in the retrieval, critical review and compilation of complex medical and scientific information. The breadth and specialisation course is to provide added value to the medical degree programme.

Knowledge and understanding

For a Pass on the course, the students shall be able to

• account for the current knowledge situation in the core subject of the course based on clinical situations, reading of scientific literature or theoretical analyses, and relate it to previous knowledge from the medical degree programme

Competence and skills

For a Pass on the course, the students shall be able to

• apply the theoretical or practical skills developed during the course and analyse their relevance and importance to situations in future professional practice

Judgement and approach

For a Pass on the course, the students shall be able to

• reflect on how the knowledge and skills developed during the course can be further developed at the levels of individuals and groups with regard to their importance for their own and colleagues' future professional practice

Course content

Depending on the character of the specific field of broadening and specialisation, the course may include theoretical or clinical components. The course can be studied in Sweden or abroad.

Course design

The teaching varies depending on the specific field of broadening and/or specialisation field addressed by the course. Compulsory components are determined by the character of the specific field.

Assessment

The forms of assessment vary depending on the the specific theoretical and/or clinical field addressed by the course.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass.

Entry requirements

To be admitted to the course, students must have passed courses (all assessed components) up to and including semester 9 of the Master of Science programme in Medicine
