Details of approval

The syllabus was approved by The pro-dean for First-Cycle Studies at the Faculties of Humanities and Theology on 2017-12-14 to be valid from 2017-12-14, spring semester 2018.

General Information

The course is offered as a freestanding course. It can normally be included in a first or second cycle degree.

Language of instruction: Swedish

Main field of studies

Latin

Depth of study relative to the degree requirements

G1F, First cycle, has less than 60 credits in first-cycle course/s as entry requirements

Learning outcomes

On completion of the course, the students shall be able to

Knowledge and understanding

- account for the syntax, morphology and vocabulary of classical Latin
- to some extent describe the stylistic and literary forms of Latin
- account for the historical and cultural-historical context and the authors of the texts studied

Competence and skills

- translate and interpret Latin classical texts and consult the comments on language and history of the editions used
- translate sentences from Swedish into Latin providing examples of the main traits of Latin grammar

Judgement and approach

- communicate the knowledge and skills in Latin acquired on the course to the surrounding world
- discuss and take a position on issues concerning Roman society and Latin from different perspectives
- assess their own need of further knowledge in Latin grammar and vocabulary

Course content

The course provides students with specialised knowledge of Latin and a developed ability to translate and interpret classical texts in Latin. Module 1 continuously highlights the grammar of the texts studied. Module 2 provides an overview and a detailed study of the most important parts of Latin grammar mainly through translation exercises into Latin.

The course consists of the following modules:

1. Republican Prose, 7 credits,
2. Syntax and Exercises in Translation, 8 credits.

Course design

The teaching consists of lectures and classes.

Assessment

The assessment is based on a written invigilated exam at the end of each module.

The examiner, in consultation with Disability Support Services, may deviate from the regular form of examination in order to provide a permanently disabled student with a form of examination equivalent to that of a student without a disability.

Subcourses that are part of this course can be found in an appendix at the end of this document.

Grades

Marking scale: Fail, Pass, Pass with distinction.

For a grade of Pass on the whole course, the student must have been awarded at least this grade on all modules. For a grade of Pass with Distinction, the student must also have been awarded a grade of Pass with Distinction on at least 8 of the credits of the course.

Entry requirements

To be admitted to the course, students must have passed LATA02 or the equivalent.

1. The course is offered at the the Centre for Languages and Literature, Lund University.
2. This course replaces the course LATA03.
3. The credits allocated for course content that in whole or in part is commensurate with another course can only be credited once for a degree. For further details see the current application information and other relevant documentation.
